## GPS/Hydrosphere Unit Glossary

anemometer a tool used to measure wind speed

**atmosphere** the layer of gases that surrounds Earth and other planets

barometer a tool used to measure air pressure

condensation the changing of a gas into a liquid

evaporation the changing of a liquid into a gas

front a boundary between two air masses

precipitation water leaving clouds as rain, snow, sleet or hail

rain gauge a tool used to measure how much rain has fallen

**sleet** frozen rain drops

sublimation when ice turns into water vapor without first melting

water cycle the path that water takes as it evaporates from oceans, lakes and other sources, condenses, and falls to Earth as precipitation, and evaporates or flows back to the sea

water table the top level of groundwater in an aquifer
